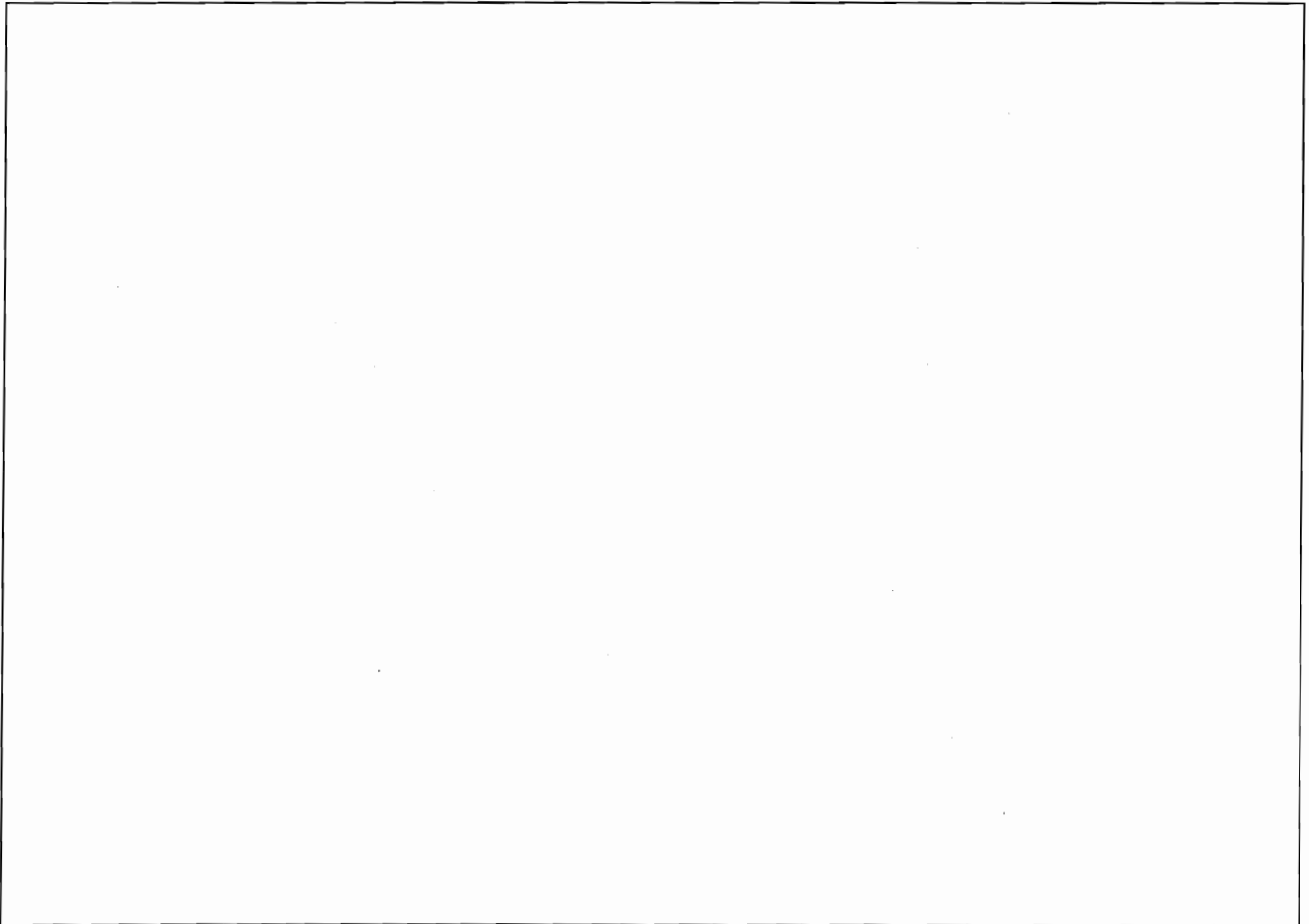

NOTES:

1. The dimensions shown must total the actual lot frontage of the property including:
 - Width distances to boundaries
 - Length of clear sight distances along road, both directions
 - Grade from frontage of road
 - Length of driveway
 - Proposed culverts (12 inch minimum)
 - Show that the driveway is 10 feet (10') from all boundaries
 - **The proposed driveway must be staked and flagged and the side boundary lines must be flagged**
2. The 911 address must be posted at the start of construction.
3. A Certificate of Occupancy may not be issued until a driveway apron is constructed and inspected by the Highway Superintendent.
