# **Western Avenue Sidewalk Project**

**The Town of Henniker, New Hampshire is seeking bids for a sidewalk installation as follows:**

Description of work:

1. Install approximately 420' vertical granite curbing with 7" reveal.
2. Remove existing pavement and sub-base material, place 12" of 1-1/2" crushed gravel base and compact at 6" intervals.
3. Install 4' round x 4' deep catch basin with a 8" sump and frame and grate with about 40' of 15" ADS N-12 or comparable pipe for outlet pipe. This is to be placed in a location specified by the town engineer or Acting Road Agent.
4. Pave 5' wide with 2" base and 1" top.
5. Patch front of curb.

6. Loam and seed back slope and any other areas that may be disturbed.
7. Project must meet handicap compliance including proper identification on ground at entry points.
8. Signage and traffic control to be included in job cost estimate.

**Per the Town's Procurement Policy, it is required that the contractor (bidder) guarantees the bid amount for a maximum of thirty days from bid opening date. The bidder shall absorb any increase in cost estimates following the bid award or signing of a contract.**

**This project is subject to available funding and will not be awarded until such time as the Selectmen officially vote to fund.**

The Henniker Board of Selectmen, through the Acting Highway Superintendent, reserves the right to reject any and all bids which in their judgment appears to be in the best interest of the Town of Henniker.
