

Henniker Historic District Commission Minutes
May 12, 2009
Town Hall Conference Room

Present: Jon Evans, Barbara Gezelman French, Martha Taylor, Danielle Bissonnette, Peter Gilbert, Arthur Kendrick, District Commissioners, Tom Dunn, Alternate Commissioner and members of the public, Rochelle Gezelman and Peter Flynn.

The meeting was opened at 9am.

1) The Public Hearing as posted was immediately opened. The topic of the hearing was a request by the Town of Henniker Parks Dept. to modify and expand certain heights of the fencing at the Town Hall Baseball Field.

Peter Flynn, representing the Town explained the changes to the fencing that were proposed. No members of the public were present that wanted to speak to the issue. The Commission members then discussed the proposal. Peter Gilbert made a motion to approve the application, Barbara French seconded. A vote was taken and it was unanimous to approve the application.

2) Arthur Kendrick and Martha Taylor reported on the Scenic By-ways meeting. No action was necessary by the Commission.

3) The marking of the memorial trees was discussed. Jon had some figures for granite blocks with brass plaques. They ranged from \$355 to \$425 at a minimum. There are three trees identified. Our consensus was that we should pay for a marker for the Bound Tree offspring and we should ask the Rotary Club to pay for the one they planted in memory of Ron Rosenbleeth and ask the family of Louis Damour to pay for his memorial marker.

4) Those members who have not returned the recruitment form were asked to do so as soon as possible.
