

Henniker Historic District Commission

Minutes
October 12, 2010
Town Hall

Present: Jon Evans, Danielle Bissonnette, Arthur Kendrick, Tom Dunn, Kris Blomback

The meeting opened at 9:05 am.

1. The minutes from the April and July meetings were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the April and July minutes. Motion passed by vote 4-0
2. There was discussion on the potential renovation project for the 2nd floor of Town Hall. Tom Dunn will talk with James Garvin, NH State Architectural Historian, about a visit to Town Hall to look at the project. Commissioners will be invited to attend.
3. There was discussion about the potential Sounding Board restoration. Tom Dunn will work with Martha Taylor and Terri Stamps on new grant funding sources including the NH Charitable Fund. James Garvin will be consulted also if/when he visits Town Hall 2nd floor.
4. There was discussion about the completed Hearse House restoration. Dan Paul of Daystar Builders installed the new wood shingle roof. This project is now complete. The cost of the roofing project was discussed. Daystar completed the work for the fixed price of \$1800 which was the amount left in the restoration fund. Daystar provided to Russ Roy an itemized actual cost of the work totaling \$4,085 including all labor and donated materials. Tom Dunn will write a letter of thanks to Daystar for donated labor and to Jon and Lucia Evans for the donated materials. Jon Evans will write up the project history and details for the Henniker Outlook, Town Report, and local newspapers.
5. There was discussion about the HDC budget request for next year. A motion was made to request \$250, which was the amount allocated to the HDC last year. Motion passed by vote 3 – 1.
6. There was discussion about the voting rights of Selectman Kris Blomback. Peter Flynn will be asked as to whether Kris has voting rights.

Meeting adjourned 9:55 am.
