1. 1. The minutes from the meeting of July 14, 2009 were reviewed and approved.
2. 2. Martha is on the process of applying to two foundations for grant funding of the sounding board restoration project. The committee was able to review one analysis at the October 13th meeting, and the second one is due for the next committee meeting.
