

Henniker Historic District Commission Minutes
July 12, 2011

Meeting was called to order at 9:06am.

Minutes of April 19, 2011 were approved as submitted.

There was no update on the 2nd floor of Town Hall.
Martha reported that the latest sounding board grant proposal was denied.

A discussion was held regarding addition of some buildings to the town's historic district. We all agreed that we would like the Grange Building, Academy Hall and the Community Center added as overlay historic districts. Jon asked the Tucker Free Library Trustees if they would be interested in adding the library building to this process. They responded that they felt the library trustees could maintain the integrity of the library building. He will ask the School Board if they would like us to add the original wooden school building. Members of this commission met with the Planning Board to discuss our interest in moving forward and they asked us to come back later in the year when they are working on next years changes to the zoning articles.

We discussed the landscaping around the World War 2 Memorial in Woodman Park out in front of the Town Hall. We voted to ask the Selectmen to approve having the Parks Department remove the two shrubs in front of the memorial.

Danielle said she would re-apply to be a commissioner. Peter will be asked to do so also.

Jon will contact the college about repairing the cemetery stone wall.
