

Henniker Historic District Commission Minutes
July 13, 2010
Town Hall conference Room

Present: Jon Evans, Martha Taylor, Tom Dunn

The meeting opened at 9:12am.

- 1) There was not a quorum present so no votes were taken.
- 2) The April minutes were reviewed.
- 3) Tom told us that Robert Brier of Show Works has retired after an accident. He asked about a generalist to look at the upstairs of Town Hall. Marc Williams was suggested.
- 4) The Council for the Arts turned down our grant for the sounding board restoration. Tom said the grant reviewers were not happy that we intended to move the sounding board. He is now going to submit a grant to the "CHIP" program through the Cultural Affairs Office that is funded with Federal Stimulus \$. It is due on October 1st and the maximum to apply for is \$25,000.
- 5) The plaque for the Bicentennial tree has been installed. Pete Fernandez was a great help in getting it done. There is drainage under the cement base. Be sure to stop and look at it.
- 6) Dan Paul submitted a bid of not more than \$1,800 for roofing the Hearse House. It does not include the 5 square of cedar shingles needed. Jon & Lucia Evans have offered to donate the shingles.[THANK YOU, JON & LUCIA.] A request for approval is being submitted to the Selectmen at the July 14th meeting.
- 7) Martha reported on the Municipal Records Committee. A workday has been scheduled for July 14th to clean up the upstairs of Town Hall. [The cleanup was held as scheduled. Three truckloads and one trailer load of trash were taken to the transfer station. The remaining records and file cabinets were moved around so that they could be worked on and sorted out more easily.]

The meeting was adjourned at 10am.
