

Henniker Historic District Commission Minutes
July 8, 2008

Present: Jon Evans, Barbara Gezelman French, Arthur Kendrick, Martha Taylor, District Commissioners, and Danielle Bissonnette, Alternate Commissioner.

- 1) The minutes were approved as amended as follows:

- 4) The future of the Quaker Meeting House and Quaker School was discussed. We decided to have Martha talk to Betty Straw to see informally if there might be a possibility of the Town having a right of first refusal if the Meeting House were to be sold.
- 5) The moving of the sounding board was discussed. Martha reported that Marc Williams, a conservator, came to town hall and reviewed the moving process with Martha & Ron Taylor. Our next step is to find a table lift. We do not need to hire a professional mover to move it without damaging it. Suggestions were made about finding help.
- 6) The Commissioners voted unanimously to thank Ging Blanchard for her years of dedicated service to the Town of Henniker through the Historic District Commission. A note thanking her will be sent.

We talked to Danielle about applying for the position of Commissioner. She will let us know by the middle of August of her decision.
