- Conservation meeting  
The meeting sponsored by the Open Space Committee of the Henniker Conservation Commission and the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests will be held 7 pm, Wednesday, October 1, 2008. Invitations were sent to 30 people in the Mink Hills area of Henniker.  
Brian Hotz, a land protection specialist from SPNHF, will present a program outlining conservation options for landowners in that area.
- Reviewed an opinion from Bart Mayer, Town Counsel, where he found it was appropriate for the town's conservation fund to be used to help fund private conservation easements. He recommended the town hold an executory interest in such an easement.
- The committee was informed that a landowner in the Craney Hill area of Henniker recently contacted Laura Scott, Town Planner, about putting land into conservation. Denise will contact her.
