

Minutes of Henniker Conservation Commission Open Space Subcommittee Meeting

- The minutes of the September subcommittee meeting were read and accepted as written
- The minutes of the October 1, informational presentation meeting were read and accepted as written.

-The committee expressed their thanks to Sher Kamman for hosting the informational meeting sponsored by the Open Space Committee of the Henniker Conservation Commission and the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests.

As a follow up to this meeting, it was decided to take the following steps:

- Bob will draft a letter to all those who attended the meeting as well as to those who had been invited but were unable to attend.
- Gail will contact Brian Hotz from the forest society to learn if he has been contacted by any of the landowners who attended the October 1st meeting. Gail will also ask Brian if he thinks it would be useful to have a second meeting in Henniker in an area that is contiguous with the Quabbin to Cardigan Greenway project.

-Sher informed the committee that a landowner who is interested in putting her land into conservation had contacted her. Gail will pass this information on to Brian Hotz.

-Denise made a motion to have the open space committee recommend to the conservation commission that the commission work with the town to obtain approval for the conservation of the town-owned property, lot 98.

- The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

-Denise will continue to gather information about other properties that could possibly be considered for conservation.

The meeting adjourned at 7:55 pm.
