6. Update on the French and Keyser Pond Phosphorus Mitigation

Goal is to develop a management plan to work towards a chemical treatment to prevent from recircling into water column and circulating the cyanobacteria. Saw improvements in oxygen concentrations and appearance towards end of August in both ponds. Last year Keyser still had slime during the warming in October. The State has given the go ahead to move forward with the project.

7. Other business

Sachie moved to approve the \$35 reimbursement to Holly for the December 7, 2020 online meeting of NHACC. Ross seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

In regards to the community school's new propane tanks, all concerns are resolved with precautions to ensure to wetland impact or someone accidently driving through the propane tanks.

OHRV Committee Ross will be the Conservation Commission representative on OHRV who met in June. At the June meeting there was a big increase in complaints and Pats Peak had to close their parking lot. Restoration work done on Chase Road was done with riprap that is terrible for walkers, hikers, bikers but great for ATVs. At this time no fall OHRV meeting has been scheduled.
