Town of Henniker Athletics Committee Meeting Monday, January 20, 2020 The Grange

The meeting was called to order 7:03pm.

The committee discussed the meeting minutes from December 16, 2019. Heather Jones made a motion to approve the December 16, 2019 meeting minutes. Chris Woodbury seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. (4-0-2 Brooks, Flynn)

Baseball/Softball

Erich Adler reported that the Baseball/Softball/T-Ball registration is open. There was discussion that both genders can play either sport. Players will be encouraged to play their traditional sport but will be allowed to play the sport they choose.

The committee discussed the issue of older players playing down an age level. It was clarified that an older player would not be allowed to play down a level due to poor skill ability. An older player, with an identified disability, may play down an age level with approval from the league.

Erich reported that the final orders placed in 2019 were picked up.

Colleen questioned purchasing new t-shirts for the k-2 programs and the possibility of players being able to keep their shirt. This will be discussed again at another meeting.
