

Town of Henniker Road Management Meeting Tuesday, August 18, 2020 Highway Department

Bill Marko moved to approve the January minutes as presented. Danny Aucoin seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Selectman Parker moved to approve the February minutes as presented. Bill Marko seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Mike Flecchia moved to approve the July minutes as amended. Bill Marko seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Highway report: A rough quote for the bridge work is mid to upper \$60,000 to redeck the bridge and an expendable bridge trust should be established.

All the paving downtown is done, came in as quoted. Work is bring done on Patterson, there is good gravel under the road and a 6in drain is being installed down the up-hill side. It is over 100 ft and there are 3 cross culverts with the first being on the gravel section of road.

Meeting with Kristine Spaulding and Heidi Dunn who have agreed to a drainage easement onto their properties for 2 more culverts to be added. Dan Higginson also granted a drainage easement for his property as well.

Leo Aucoin is working with TDS in regards to bringing fiber optics downtown from Abby's café toward the Henniker Bed and Breakfast.

Gulf Rd had dry culverts due to the drought and was an opportune time to hand mix cement and dry seal the culverts. There was a fuel tank leak but that has been repaired already.

Guard rails on the Old Hillsboro Road over pass bridge are rotted out, don't hit them. Leo is working with the State and Federal government on flood water at Mr. Bordon's house. Was asked by State if any grants being used, Leo stated no all through taxation.

For 2021 Depot, Bennet, Elm and Circle are on the radar. The next meeting will discuss the specs on Old Hillsboro Rd as well as beginning the culvert inventory at some date.
