Highway Report:

- The department is working with a skeleton crew.
- Western Ave has been delayed several times. They are burying as many small pipes as they can with 3-4 workers out there. Drop inlets are too high on several pipes
- Old Hillsboro Road needs pipes changed.
- The guard rail on 202/9 overpass needs to be done on Old Hillsboro Road.
- Getting trucks ready for winter, all are in working condition just short on operators.
- Permit to fix the flooding at Mr. Bordon's has gone back to the Feds
- Future developments will need to be piped on both sides to contain and disperse water
- Set up meeting with Water Commissioners regarding Depot Street to coordinate work efforts

2021 Budget

The department will be requesting \$750,000 again at Town Meeting. The money will be used for culvert work on Old Hillsboro Road, finishing Western Ave, drainage on Depot Street, guard rail projects on Fairview Ave/Old Concord Road/ Old Hillsboro Road, Elm & Elm Street extension.

Re-evaluate report of road conditions for next meeting and update charts.
